Northeast Flat-Coated Retriever Club's Versatility Award

The Purpose:

This award is to encourage NEFCRC members to train, work and show their dogs in more than one area of interest. This award will honor the dog who has proven his ability as a multi-purpose dog. At the same time, it will give the owner incentive to pursue new areas of interest and stretch the dog's talents. Although the Flat-Coat is a breed that prides itself as a multi-purpose dog, we are in danger of splitting into two groups (show vs. working lines). This award is one small effort to try to keep the breed together, and foster exchanges in expertise among club members. Although most useful for motivating new owners, this award may kindle some interest with the senior members, if not for themselves, possibly for their puppy buyers.

To Qualify:

The Owner must be a club member in good standing during the time the dog has achieved the two required titles. The second title has to have been earned after the starting date of this award program, January 1, 1992. Those who have gained titles in two or more areas prior to the starting date will not qualify for a free plaque, but can purchase the plaque from the club if they desire. Thereafter, the club will provide additional plates as the dog continues to earn titles.
